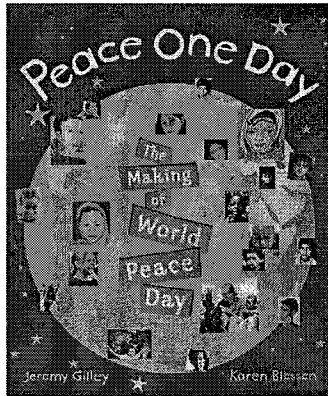
Thank you to all who have turned in their Library Authorization Forms. The Library is now open for our students.
